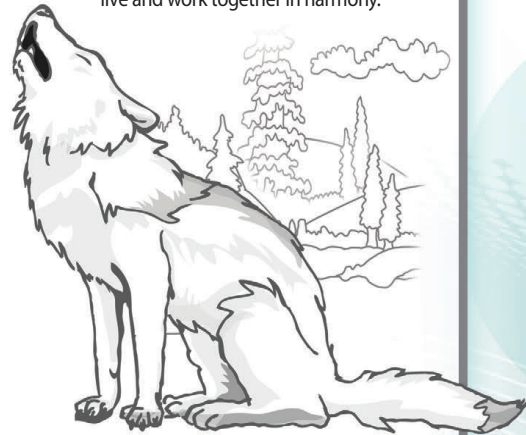
Respect
