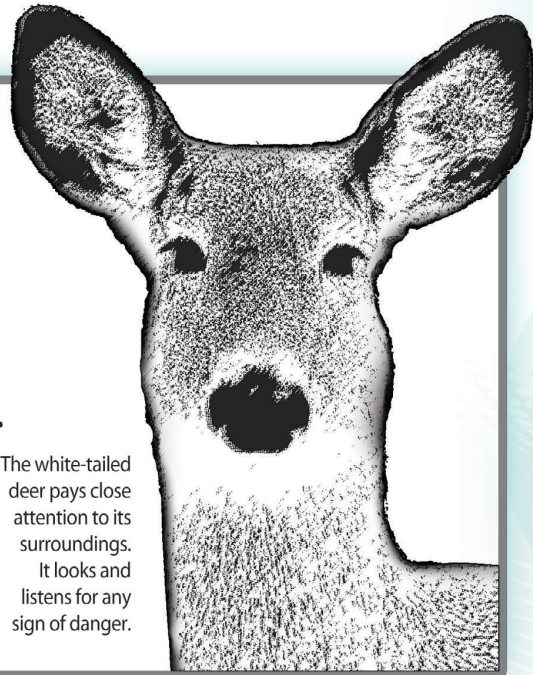
Attentiveness
