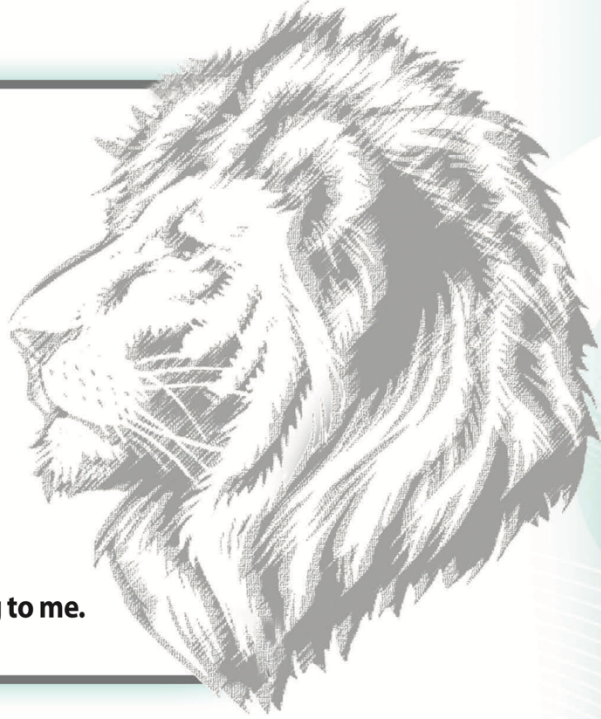
## Honesty
