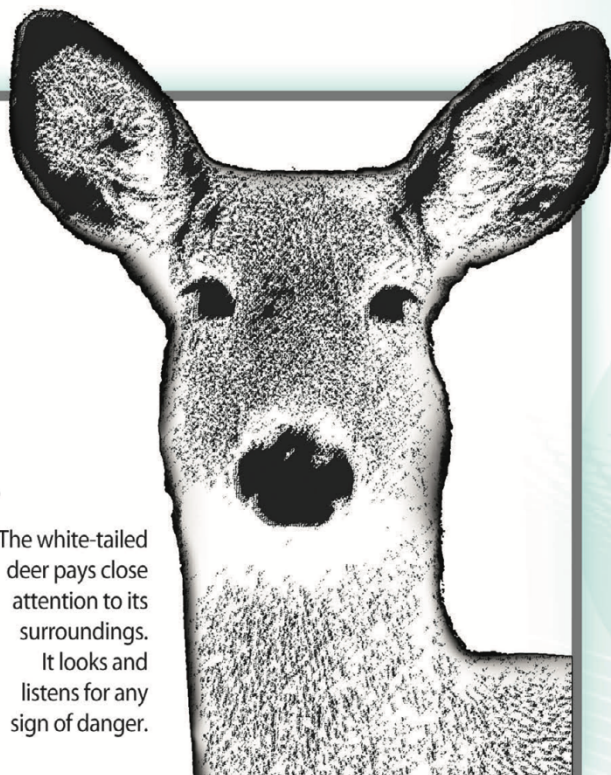
Attentiveness
